Applicants for Pre-Kindergarten	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students who are registered for Pre-Kindergarten and have a completed application to the academy on file will be eligible to participate in the admissions process.
Applicants for Kindergarten	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students who are eligible for Kindergarten and have a completed application to the academy on file will be eligible to participate in the admissions process.
Applicants for 1st Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Currently identified as GT OR NPR score of 65th percentile or above in Math or Reading on a norm-referenced assessment.
Applicants for 2nd Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Currently identified as GT, OR• First semester grade average of 82 in core subjects (Math, Science, Social Studies, and Reading/Language arts), AND• NPR Score of 65th percentile or above in Math or Reading on norm-referenced assessment.
Applicants for 3rd Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Currently identified as GT, OR• First semester grade average of 82 in core subjects (Math, Science, Social Studies, and Reading/Language arts), AND• NPR Score of 65th percentile or above in Math or Reading on norm-referenced assessment.
Applicants for 4th Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Currently identified as GT, OR• First semester grade average of 82 in core subjects (Math, Science, Social Studies, and Reading/Language arts), AND• NPR Score of 65th percentile or above in Math or Reading on norm-referenced assessment.
Applicants for 5th Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Currently identified as GT, OR• First semester grade average of 82 in core subjects (Math, Science, Social Studies, and Reading/Language arts), AND• 3rd grade Math STAAR score of 1486 (Spanish 1486), OR 3rd grade Reading STAAR score of 1468 (Spanish 1444), OR NPR score of 65th percentile or above in math or reading on norm-referenced assessment.
Applicants for 6th Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Currently identified as GT, OR• First semester grade average of 82 in core subjects (Math, Science, Social Studies, and Reading/Language arts), AND• 4th grade math STAAR score of 1589 (Spanish 1589), OR 4th grade Reading STAAR score of 1550 (Spanish 1539), OR NPR score of 65th percentile or above in math or reading on norm-referenced assessment.
