- The high achievers' recognition for students and staff honored students in grades Pre-K to 8 who showed the most significant percentage of academic growth in the course subjects of reading and math. This month, DeSoto ISD also recognized teachers who achieved the most significant academic growth of their students in English Language Arts/Reading and Math during the 2021 school year. Parents brought their students to receive this public recognition.

 The progress measures covered in this agenda presentation included data review and conversations around Board Goal 4: Individual Growth.

 - This brief presentation of the Board Corrective Action Plan identified the completion of theSet the Vision objective regarding board-led Lone Star Governance training and the Implementing the Vision Objective regarding the literacy-focused progress measures.
- The Administration Corrective Action Plan update was shared by Superintendent Weaver.
 - This brief presentation shared a significant percentage of improvement on the academic progress measures regarding instructional model and a smaller gain on the progress measure regarding a tiered system of support. The talent management objectives showed improvement with only two areas off-track and slightly off-track respectively.
